## **SPIRITED MEDICINE: Shamanism in Contemporary Healthcare**

SSP has a new book coming out at the end of this year entitled "Spirited Medicine: Shamanism in Contemporary Healthcare," edited by Cecile Carson, MD, with Tom Cowan, José Stevens, and Bonnie Horrigan. Contributors include many Society members, and the book is an exciting contribution to the integration

of shamanism into modern western society, tracing by example how shamanism is shaping western healthcare and being shaped by it in turn. The book offers both a broad perspective on re-introducing soul into the healing process of western medicine, as well as clinical examples and practical strategies for healthcare and shamanic practitioners alike. It covers a broad range of healthcare settings: surgery, psychotherapy, rehabilitation medicine, family medicine, naturopathy, osteopathy, hospice care, and a general medical clinic to name a few.


